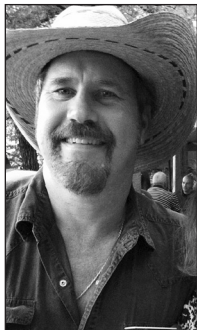


John Alden Wiesner
