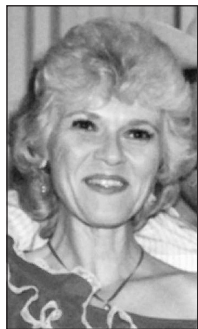


**Mrs. Harry F. Wilke**
